

## Chaos Game – Instructions for Kids and Teens

### Game Idea:

The Chaos Game is a wild, action-packed group game for 10 or more players, best played outdoors or in a large indoor space. The goal is to complete as many tasks as possible by running chaotically through the play area, searching for numbered clue cards, and completing small challenges.

### Game Preparation:

- Print 30 numbered cards (1 to 30) and place them visibly around the play area.
- Prepare a list of 30 tasks or quiz questions (either written on the back of the cards or kept by the game leader).
- Each team needs a game piece on the board or a points card.
- You will need one die and a game leader.

### How to Play:

1. Each team rolls the die and searches for the card with the corresponding number.
2. The card has a code word (or one is given verbally), which the team brings to the game leader.
3. The team receives a task or quiz question. If answered or completed correctly, they may roll again.
4. If the answer is incorrect, the team moves one space back and must find a new code word.

### End of the Game:

The game ends after 60–90 minutes or when one team has successfully completed all tasks.

### Tips:

- Place cards where they're easy to spot — chaotic yes, frustrating no.
- Make tasks fun and varied — physical, creative, tricky!
- Play music for extra energy!
